#### What is JumpStart?

- JumpStart is Dual Enrollment specifically for HCPSS Students.
- Flexible vs. Structured Options
- The ability to get college credit by registering for a course that you don't have to be at HCC for.



#### What is Dual Credit?

- Dual Credit:
  - A course that fulfills a high school and college requirement.
  - Dual credit can be offered in select courses in the high school and on HCC's campus.
- Credits:
  - High school courses = 1 credit, College typically = 3 credits
  - Credits = the amount of hours spent in the class
  - HCC houses a transcript with your credit on it, this does not necessarily tie you to attending HCC after high school.

- Apply to HCC
   (Online @ Howardcc.edu)
- Sign the Statement of Understanding (Online @ HCPSS.me through Synergy)
- 3. Submit the signed registration form to your teacher
- 4. Pay for your course



#### **Payment**

- Students participating in this program receive a 50% tuition discount
- A bill will be mailed to your house and found in your HCC portal.
- Payment is accepted by credit card in person, over the phone, or through your HCC Portal.
- Students who receive Free and Reduced Meals (FARMS) qualify for additional tuition assistance.
